If by chance you see fine black lines across the graphics do not worry, they will not print. It is due to some video monitor's drives incompatibility. You can make them go away by enlarging or reducing the size you see through 'View" in your grey Menu Bar.

You can print as many copies of this sheet as you want.

Be sure to specify 'Print Page 2 to 2' in the print dialog box so that you don't print this opening page each time you print. The default setting is to print both pages if you don't change it.

For best results, use your printer's 'high quality' setting, but for something like these checks, the 'fast' setting may be fine for your purposes.

This sample has both sizes of checks shown. The set includes only full sheets of one size of checks. I did the sample this way for you to see both examples at once.

To get the largest print, change the 'layout' setting from 'Fit to Page' to '100%'. You can change the percentage to smaller settings for reduced size prints for really mini checks.
